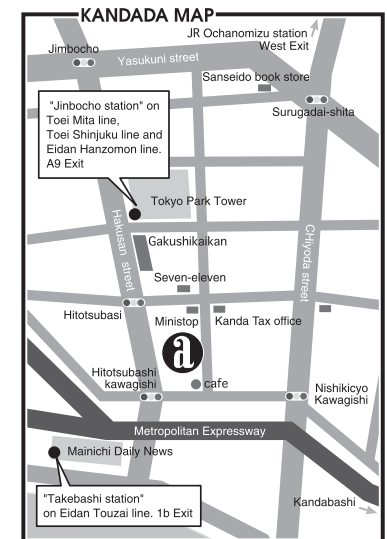

*Tokyo Rabbit Paradise (TRaP) is a KANDADA opening project.



Tokyo Rabbit Paradise is a project considering the merits of staying in "Rabbit paradise" rather than complaining about our "Rabbit house" circumstance in Tokyo from an artist's viewpoint. Rabbit house is a Japanese metaphorical expression, meaning small house. Video works by Tokyo-based artists devised to give viewers a new, varied and different angle on Tokyo will be presented. This project has been to several cities around the world since May 2001 including London (U.K), Venice (Italy), Sydney (Australia), Paris (France), Milan (Italy), Weimar (Germany) and Pescara (Italy). Finally the works are back at home in Tokyo.
